

Answering Questions from the Public Lakes Region Composting Pilot Program

1) How do I sign up for the program?

Ans: Contact your local program coordinator to sign up.

2) Do I have to attend the training in person?

Ans: Yes, all participants need to attend the training in person.

3) Can I just get a free tumbler and not attend the training?

Ans: No, you must attend the training to receive a free tumbler. This program has been proved through a USDA grant (CFWR) which requires all participants to attend composting training before receiving a free composting tumbler.

4) Do I have to take a survey and how many are there?

Ans: Yes, you must take all surveys and there is a total of 4. One survey will be completed in person with the training you attend, and the rest will be online.

5) Does this program cost any money to participate?

Ans: No, the program is free for residents to participate.

6) I am from a community other than the ones listed, can I still participate?

Ans: This program is limited to the 5 communities who have partnered with LRPC through the USDA grant. The project's training and data collection are specifically designed for these communities. However, if others are interested, we are happy to take their name and contact information as we continue to build the program.

7) Can I attend a training course in place of someone else that signed up?

Ans: If you are apart of the same household, you can attend the training in place of someone from the same household that signed up.

8) What if I do not use a computer but would like to participate in the program?

Ans: Have them call Matt Rose (603-279-5336) and discuss their barrier. Anyone participating will have to take all 4 surveys (3 online), but we may be able to work out a solution for the participant.
