

InvestNH Housing

- New Hampshire's overall rental vacancy rate is 0.5% (New Hampshire Housing Finance Authority)
- 23,670 housing units needed today to alleviate housing shortage
- Nearly 90,000 units are needed between 2020 and 2040
- InvestNH's Capital Grant program created to contribute to stabilizing affordable rental housing market



InvestNH Housing

\$100 million to stabilize the *affordable* housing market

Capital Grant Awards Award Caps

\$3,000,000 cap per project

Municipal Per Unit – Permit Incentive Award Caps

- \$10,000 per unit permitted
- \$1 million per project
- \$1 million per municipality

Municipal Demolition Grant – Reimbursement

Award Caps

- \$500,000 per municipality
- \$500,000 per project



Capital Grant Program \$50 million

*Capital Grant Program awards have closed

Municipal Per Unit Grant (MPU) \$30 million

Municipal Demolition Grant (MDG) \$5 million

Municipal Planning and Zoning Grant \$5 million

NHFFA Capital Subsidy \$10 million
