Supported by the <u>U.S. Department of Energy's Clean Cities Program</u>, and hosted by the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, the Granite State Clean Cities Coalition works to reduce petroleum use in New Hampshire's transportation sector by assisting public and private vehicle fleets, businesses, and municipalities in adopting affordable, domestic transportation fuels, advanced vehicle technologies, and other fuel-saving strategies.

The U.S. consumes approximately 20 million barrels of petroleum per day, about three-fourths of which is used for transportation. Using less diesel and gasoline in our vehicles, engines, and equipment helps to reduce our nation's dependence on foreign oil while improving our air quality.

Each year, GSCCC collects data from our stakeholders and partners who are implementing clean transportation projects in New Hampshire. These projects reduce petroleum use and greenhouse gas emissions from the transportation sector.
